The Idaho Conservation Officers Association was founded in 1980 and is comprised of nearly every Conservation Officer working in the State of Idaho. These men and women are responsible for the enforcement of Idaho state law with a focus on the protection and management of fish and wildlife within the State. The association provides a space for Conservation Officers to share experiences, a common love of wildlife, and connect with national organizations like the North American Wildlife Officers Association and the National Fraternal Order of Police.

Idaho Conservation Officers recognize the importance of wildlife law enforcement and the need for trained, educated individuals willing to work in the field. To this end, students wanting to pursue a career in wildlife conservation are encouraged to apply for one of three scholarships in the amount of **\$1000.00** offered each year. Preference will be given to college students, in good standing and at least a sophomore, who demonstrate an interest in resource conservation law enforcement.

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a currently registered full-time student (12 credits minimum)
- Must be a sophomore, junior, senior, or graduate student.
- Must have a declared major in a natural resource related field.
- Preference will be given to first time applicants.
- Applicants must have a minimum 2.5 accumulated grade point average.
- Applicants who are already receiving a full ride athletic or academic scholarship will not be considered.
- Applicants should attach a headshot photo as well as a one-page essay outlining their academic goals and objectives.
